

TERMS OF SERVICE

LearnArmenia

Effective Date: 25.04.2026

1. Introduction

Welcome to LearnArmenia ("Service", "Platform", "we", "us", "our").

LearnArmenia is an online digital platform providing access to Armenian language learning materials, exercises, training tools, audio content, and related digital educational resources (the "Digital Content").

By accessing or using the Service, you agree to be legally bound by these Terms of Service ("Terms"). If you do not agree, you must not use the Service.

Unless otherwise stated, the Service is intended for personal use by users located in the Republic of Armenia.

2. Nature of the Service

2.1 LearnArmenia provides self-study access to digital educational content for learning Eastern Armenian.

2.2 The Service does not constitute formal education, accredited instruction, certification, or licensed educational services.

2.3 Access to Digital Content is granted for personal, non-commercial use only.

2.4 The Service is currently provided free of charge. If paid features, donations, or other paid options are introduced later, additional terms may apply before any payment is taken.

3. Eligibility

We reserve the right to suspend or restrict accounts if these requirements are not met.

3.1 You must be at least 14 years old to use the Service.

3.2 If you are under 18 years old, you confirm that you have permission from a parent or legal guardian.

3.3 By registering, signing in, or otherwise using the Service, you represent that you meet these requirements.

4. Accounts, Registration, and Sign-In

We may suspend or terminate accounts at our sole discretion, including in cases of abuse, fraud, or breach of these Terms.

4.1 To access certain features, you must create an account or sign in through an available authentication method.

4.2 You may register using email and password, or sign in with Google Sign-In where available.

4.3 When creating a profile, LearnArmenia may ask for an email address, password, and nickname. A nickname is used instead of requiring your legal or real name for ordinary use of the Service.

4.4 If you choose Google Sign-In, you authorize us to receive the authentication data needed to verify your identity and create or access your LearnArmenia account.

4.5 You agree to provide accurate information and to keep it reasonably up to date.

4.6 You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your login credentials and for the security of any third-party account used to sign in.

5. Security, Cloudflare, and Abuse Prevention

To deliver, secure, and protect the Service, traffic to LearnArmenia may pass through Cloudflare proxy and security infrastructure.

Certain forms, registration steps, sign-in flows, password recovery actions, or other sensitive operations may require Cloudflare Turnstile or similar automated abuse-prevention checks. As part of this verification, your IP address may be transmitted to Cloudflare together with the security token.

You must not bypass, interfere with, automate around, or otherwise attempt to defeat technical protection measures, rate limits, anti-bot checks, or other security controls used by the Service.

6. Acceptable Use

You agree not to:

6.1 use the Service unlawfully or in violation of applicable law;

6.2 hack, probe, overload, disrupt, reverse engineer, or otherwise interfere with the Platform;

6.3 use bots, scraping tools, scripts, or other automation except where expressly permitted by us;

6.4 share account access with third parties;

6.5 attempt to access content, accounts, or infrastructure you are not authorized to access;

6.6 use the Service for commercial redistribution, training resale, or other commercial exploitation.

Violation may result in immediate restriction or termination of access without prior notice.

7. Intellectual Property

All Digital Content, exercises, lesson structures, audio materials, text, graphics, datasets, algorithms, rankings, and training systems made available through the Service are owned by LearnArmenia or used with permission and are protected by applicable intellectual property laws.

You may not, except where expressly permitted by law:

7.1 copy or reproduce the Digital Content;

7.2 distribute, republish, sell, sublicense, or commercially exploit the content;

7.3 modify, translate, adapt, or create derivative works from protected materials;

7.4 share account access or paid-for access rights, if such rights are introduced later.

Access is granted only as a limited, revocable, non-transferable, non-exclusive license for personal use.

8. AI-Assisted and Third-Party Services

Some materials, examples, or supporting content may be created or assisted by artificial intelligence technologies. We do not guarantee absolute accuracy, completeness, or linguistic perfection of all materials, and the Service is provided for informational and training purposes only.

The Service may rely on third-party services and infrastructure, including Google for optional sign-in and Cloudflare for traffic delivery, proxying, and abuse prevention. Your use of those integrations may also be subject to the third parties' own terms and privacy practices.

9. Service Availability

9.1 The Service is provided "as is" and "as available".

9.2 We do not guarantee uninterrupted, secure, or error-free operation at all times.

9.3 We may modify, suspend, or discontinue all or any part of the Service at any time without liability.

10. Limitation of Liability

To the maximum extent permitted by Armenian law:

10.1 we are not liable for indirect, incidental, special, or consequential damages;

10.2 we are not liable for loss of data, loss of profits, loss of access, or educational outcomes;

10.3 where liability cannot be excluded, our total liability will not exceed the amount, if any, paid by you to LearnArmenia during the 3 months preceding the event giving rise to the claim.

Your use of the Service is at your own risk.

11. Termination

We may terminate, suspend, or restrict access to the Service at any time, with or without notice, including where we reasonably believe there has been misuse, fraudulent activity, or a breach of these Terms.

You may stop using the Service at any time.

12. Privacy and Data Handling

Your use of the Service is also governed by our Privacy Policy.

LearnArmenia uses a nickname-based profile model. We do not require your real or legal name for ordinary use of the learning platform.

LearnArmenia does not intentionally maintain IP addresses as part of user profiles, learner progress, or ordinary account records. However, technical connection data, including IP addresses, may be processed by infrastructure and security providers, including Cloudflare proxy services, Cloudflare Turnstile, hosting providers, or Google authentication services, when this is necessary to deliver, secure, or authenticate access to the Service.
